# WHAT IS A DRILLER'S HELPER?

Reporting to the Driller, the Driller's Helper supports the Driller in obtaining core samples. This requires heavy physical work such as pulling rods, emptying core tubes, assisting in drill set-ups, performing routing maintenance on drill equipment and other related activities performed in accordance with Hy-Tech procedures and safe work practices.

A Driller's Helper starting wage is \$20.00 per hour.
