ELIGIBILITY

Scholarship applications will be accepted from a student in Grade 12 who is planning to pursue a full-time post-secondary education.

2. Current official transcript of Grade 11 and Grade 12 courses.
3. A signed copy of the Permission for Release of Personal Information form (below)

4. Reference letter from teacher or community member
5. Cover letter describing why you are a good candidate for the scholarship.

3. Identify as an Indigenous Person from Northern Saskatchewan.
