ELIGIBILITY

Scholarship applications will be accepted from students in Grade 12 who are planning to pursue a full-time post-secondary education.

HOW TO APPLY

The following information must be included to be considered for this scholarship:

1. Completed application form
 2. Current official transcript of Grade 11 and Grade 12 courses.
 3. A signed copy of the Permission for Release of Personal Information form (below)

 5. Cover letter describing why you are a good candidate for the scholarship.
